
7.5 Club Newsletters in Kete



Clubs can use Kete to distribute newsletters ... The advantage of this include:

- No photocopying costs.
- No postage costs.
- Members can use the Kete RSS feed facility to be advised of any updates.

RSS Feeds:

- RSS stands for Really Simple Syndication.
- You can use RSS feeds to monitor changes to Kete and in your club's newsletter topic and be notified via the 'feed reader' of your choice (e.g. Bloglines).
- A feed reader is a web-based program that manages all of your RSS feeds so that you can read them.
- This works differently depending on the Internet browser you are using ...

To set up an RSS feed from Kete:


- 1 Do a search on the full name of the newsletter topic (including the double quotes).
- 2 Click on RSS Feed for these items button at bottom of the search results.

If you choose BlogLines, it will take you to a screen to sign up with BlogLines.

Click on the Subscribe Now button.

And click on the OK button.
