

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Council held on Monday evening the 7th Sept. 1908 at 9 o'clock.

Present: The Mayor (Mr. B. R. Gardner) + C^o. Hall
Hankins, Hudson, Douglas, Levy, Mackenzie
Ryder, Pruse + Williams.

The Meeting which was duly summoned and constituted was called for the purpose of making a Special Order, striking a Special Rate in connection with the Gasworks Loan of £10,000.

The Mayor Moved + Councilor Williams seconded the following resolution:

Special Order. In pursuance + exercise of the power vested in it in that behalf by "The Local Bodies Loans Act 1901" and the Acts amending the same passed hereby, the Levin Borough Council hereby resolves as follows: - That for the purpose of providing interest + other charges on a loan of £10,000 authorized to be raised by the said Levin Borough Council under the above mentioned Acts, for purchasing Gas Plant, mains, material, site for Gasworks, + generally for erecting, constructing, and establishing Municipal Coal-Gasworks, the said Levin Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of nine-fifteenths of a penny in the £1 upon the rateable Capital value of all rateable property of the Borough of Levin comprising all that area in the Wellington Land District situated in Block I Wairoa Survey District bounded towards the north-east by the north-western side of Kawhia Road from Tin Tin Road to Bartholomew Road; thence towards the south-east by the north-western side of the said Bartholomew Road and the north-western side of that road produced to a south-western boundary line of subdivision No. 10 Arrowhuna Block; thence towards the south-west by the south-western boundary line of the said subdivision No. 10 to the Wellington-Manawatu Railway Reserve; thence by a right line across the said Railway Reserve and the main

Road to the North-eastern side of the Arrowhenna Beach
 Road; thence by the North-eastern side of the Arrowhenna Beach
 Road to a point in a line with the North-western boundary
 line of allotment No. 104 Werarua Township; thence towards the North-
 west by a right line to the western-most corner of the said allot-
 ment No. 104; thence by the North-western boundary lines of
 Allotments Nos. 107, 106, 105 and 104 Werarua Township aforesaid,
 and the production of the last mentioned boundary-line across
 the Makomako Road to the North-eastern side of that road;
 thence again towards the South-west by the North-eastern side of
 the said Makomako Road to Tiwhiro Road; and thence again towards
 the North-west by the South-eastern side of the said Tiwhiro Road
 to its junction with the Kawhia Road aforesaid the place of commencement,
 and that such special rate shall be an
 annual recurring rate during the currency
 of such loan, and be payable yearly on
 the first day of October in each and
 every year during the currency of such
 loan, being a period of 26 years or until
 the loan is fully paid off.

Moved by The Mayor and seconded by
 C^o Hudson - "That the foregoing "Special
 Order" making a special rate in connection
 with the Gasworks loan of £10,000 be
 duly advertised and submitted for con-
 firmation at the ordinary meeting of this
 Council be held on Monday the 5th October
 1908, at 8 o'clock.
