"the local authority in that behalf the
"Levin Borough Council do now by this
"Special Order make and create By-
"laws for the Borough of Levin, which
"shall come into force on and after
"the 1st day of October 1906, and shall
"continue in force thereafter until altered
"or revoked by the said Council, the
"subject-matter of the said By-laws
