The question as to which Bank the Council should deal with was first considered. C<sup>r</sup>. Hankins moved + C<sup>r</sup>. ~~Hankins~~ <sup>Ryder</sup> seconded "That this Council open their Banking Accounts with the Bank of Australasia Levin." This was carried by seven

votes to two Councillors Mackenzie and Palmer voting against the motion.

The Council then went into Committee to consider the applications for the positions of Poundkeeper and Night-soil man.

On resuming it was moved by C<sup>r</sup>. Hankins and seconded by C<sup>r</sup>. Palmer "That the report & recommendation of the Committee be confirmed viz, that Mr. Musgrove be appointed Poundkeeper, and Mr. Geo. Ashidge be the employee of the Council for the removal of night-soil." This motion was carried.
